



## SECTION III: STUDENT POLICY 3070

### Truancy Policy

In order to ensure the safety of all students, Insight School of Oklahoma monitors participation on a daily basis. Students that do not engage in assignments on a consistent basis may be referred to the Department of Human Services or be considered truant. For the purposes of truancy, absences will be determined daily as follows: not completing at least one course assignment or actively participating in an assigned Class Connect session. Students will be considered absent if the minimum number of assignments completed or Class Connect sessions attended in 10 consecutive days is less than four. At that time if no communication has been returned to the school personnel and/or school administrator, the student will be withdrawn for truancy, and a petition for truancy may be filed in the family's district court of residence. The truancy case may remain open until the student re-engages in ISOK; or, the ISOK registrar receives either a confirmation of enrollment from another public school district, or the parent completes the Intent to Homeschool form.
