



SECTION III: STUDENT POLICY 3040

Self-Administration of Prescribed Asthmatic, Diabetic, or Anaphylaxis Medication

Insight School of Oklahoma shall permit the self-administration of inhaled asthma medication by a student for treatment of asthma and the self-administration of anaphylaxis medication by a student for treatment of anaphylaxis at all in person, school sponsored events, including but not limited to state testing, outings, prom and graduation, when deemed necessary by a licensed physician. The parent or legal guardian is responsible for submitting the Medication Authorization Form to the school and supplying an emergency supply of the medication. A student may self-administer prescribed asthmatic, diabetic, or anaphylaxis medication if the self-carry/self-administration section on the Medication Authorization Form has been completed by a parent/guardian and the physician. Students with an approved Medication Authorization Form on file shall be permitted to possess and use a prescribed inhaler or anaphylaxis medication including, but not limited to, an Epinephrine injector at all times. The Medication Authorization Form will be valid for the current school year.
